- Life skills, essential skills and business communication skills

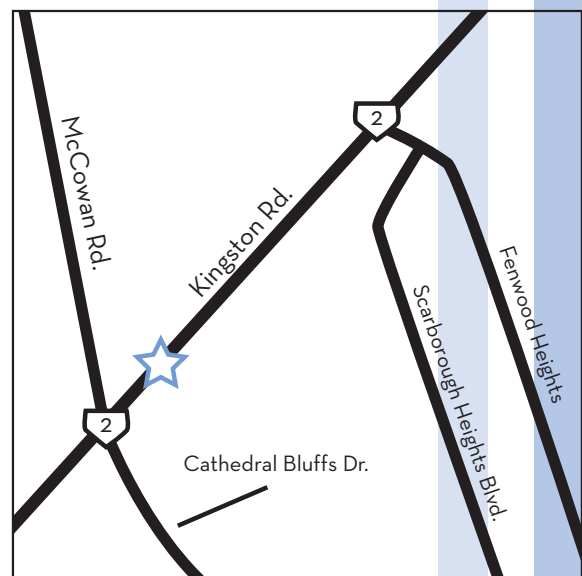
