BOOST YOUR PRONUNCIATION AND COMMUNICATION SKILLS SESSION BREAKDOWN

First Session: Wednesday, January 15, 2025

- Individual pronunciation assessments to help focus on what each participant needs improvement on.
- Steps to success based on individual assessments.
- Discussion on vocal clarity.

Second Session: Monday, January 20, 2025

- Participants will be placed in groups based on similar pronunciation difficulties.
- Specific instructions will be given to each group to perfect their pronunciation.

Third Session: Wednesday, January 22, 2025

- Group work on pronunciation.
- Developing and improving your skills with peers.
- Impromptu speaking during class.
- Confidence building to combat interactions seen as intimidating.

Fourth Session: Monday, January 27, 2025

- Discussions.
- Reading out loud.
- Pronunciation corrections.
- Answering questions.

Fifth Session: Wednesday, January 29, 2025

- Job related topics presentation.
- Constructive feedback to improve pronunciation and communication ongoing.
