YWCA Toronto – Women in Trades and Technology (WiTT) offers women and gender diverse people a chance to build a sustainable future in non-traditional occupations for women. The STAR 4-Women (Skilled Trades Awareness & Readiness) program is a 8-week program providing skilled-trades assessment, health and safety training and certifications, job preparations, labour market information, hands-on experience with equipment and tools, and support with skilled trade pathways and opportunities. Next program cohort begins January 2025. Join this information session to learn about STAR 4-Women program, eligibility and requirements to apply. *The eligibility for our WiTT programs extends to Ontario residents who hold Canadian citizenship, Permanent Resident, and Convention Refugees.* *Unfortunately, due to our funding criteria, we are unable to register Refugee Claimants, work permit, international students with work permit.
