FREE - FILE YOUR 2023 INCOME TAX RETURN

For Newcomer Women and gender diverse people to Canada

Volunteers from the Community Volunteer Income Tax Program (CVITP) will be on hand to prepare returns for eligible taxpayers who have low to modest incomes, simple tax situations, and are Permanent Residents or Convention Refugees, CUAET residents or Live in Care Givers with a work permit.

It is important to file a tax return even if you had no income, or if you landed in Canada in 2023. You should also file to continue to receive the Child Tax Benefit, GST/HST rebate, Climate Action Incentive, and other benefits where applicable.

Please call 416.964.3883 to request an appointment. A staff member will discuss your eligibility, the information you require to file your return, confirm an appointment time, and send you a zoom invite.

To determine modest income, use the following chart.

Family Size	Total Family Income
1 Person	Under \$35,000
2 Persons	Under \$45,000
3 Persons	Under \$47,500
4 Persons	Under \$50,000

To comply with Public Health directives and preserve the safety of clients and staff, we will be offering a combination of online, in-person and blended learning programs. Staff remains available to serve you via phone, video-conferencing or email.

For each additional dependent you have, add \$2,500 to the family income. You should not have interest income of more than \$1,000.

**Please note: due to funding criteria, we are unable to serve Canadian Citizens and Refugee Claimants at this time. Your Permanent Resident card or immigration documentation will be required to register.*
